Magical Mystery Tour, Plain and Outline Shadow, are two fonts based on the lettering used for the Beatles' Magical Mystery Tour record sleeve of 1967.

### K-TYPE LICENCE AGREEMENT

#### FREE FONTS (Unlicensed)

K-Type Free Fonts are provided free for personal use, you don't require a licence to use them among your friends and family. However, free fonts used for business or promotional purposes, or as webfonts, need to be licensed by purchasing the appropriate Commercial Licence or Enterprise Licence.

#### COMMERCIAL LICENCE (Normal Licence)

A Commercial Licence grants you non-exclusive rights to use the font for normal graphic design purposes in print and on screen. The font may be stored on up to five workstations and output devices belonging to you; multiple licences can be purchased where more seats are required. You cannot legally give the font to others or install it on their machines (with the exception of co-workers, your designer and your service bureau). You can embed the font securely in non-editable documents.

A Commercial Licence permits @font-face use without any pageview limitations. Basic form field inputs are permitted, for example a search box or contact form, but providing remote users with the ability to edit, personalise and dynamically generate design using webfonts is not allowed. To incorporate a K-Type font file within your software product or your website to create user-generated graphics 'on the fly', or for use on an unlimited number of workstations, a more comprehensive Enterprise Licence should be purchased from k-type.com

#### ENTERPRISE LICENCE (Extended Licence)

An Enterprise Licence is required where a font will be incorporated within software products such as apps, games, ebooks or computer programs intended for resale, redistribution or promotional purposes. An Enterprise Licence covers one or more of your applications.

An Enterprise Licence permits @font-face use without any pageview limitations, and also allows you to give remote users the ability to edit text and dynamically generate design using webfonts.

An Enterprise Licence permits the font to be stored on an unlimited number of workstations and output devices belonging to you, and grants non-exclusive rights to use the font for normal graphic design purposes in print and on screen. An Enterprise Licence is not transferable to others.

#### CUSTOM FONTS

Commissioning a K-Type Custom Font grants you ownership upon payment – sole rights to use the font autonomously, exclusively and indefinitely.

*Fonts are supplied "as is". Every effort is made to ensure that the files will behave properly, and whilst mistakes and omissions are corrected cheerfully and quickly, K-Type will not be liable for losses incurred by 'software failure'.*

### INSTALLING FONTS

Fonts are placed in your operating system's Fonts folder and will be made available to all the applications or programs you use.

#### WINDOWS

Put the font file (.ttf or .otf) into C:\Windows\Fonts, or right-click on the font files > Install

#### MAC

Put the font file (.ttf, or .otf) into /Library/Fonts
